Outcomes to Date:
<p>Participation A baseline is needed (Autumn term) to determine an average Physical Activity per week.</p> <p>Progress Assessment and observation of Kenn staff teaching PE (Spring Term) to plan for 2017-2018</p> <p>Intervention Within the Spring term a trained LSA will be taking on a tiger team club (fun fit) to help children with fine/gross motor skills. This will happen x3 afternoons a week for 30 minutes.</p>

Pupil Premium planned spending for 2017 – 2018

Funding for the next two years will buy into:

- CPD opportunities for Staff
- Mini bus lease
- Premier sport package + the possibility of healthy eating/ living lessons
- Forest school teacher + TA to work x4 afternoons (across the federation) to walk children to the allotment to grow food which can then be cooked or to go on trips in the mini bus (Haldon hill, etc)
- Cookery club (after school)
- Training a Meal time assistant to teach groups of Y5/6 children to be sports leaders who can then organise sports/ games/ exercises for the rest of the school at lunchtimes.
- Skipping event (Skip2Bfit?) to promote more exercise at lunchtimes which can then be maintained by an MTA at lunchtimes.
